Topic: Why Updates Actually Matter

Chip's Weekly Cheat Sheet: Mar-16 

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1. Plugging the Security Holes

- Most updates aren't for "new features"—they are "patches" that fix security holes scammers use to get into your system.
- **Chip's Tip: Updating your software is like checking the locks on your front door.**

2. Better Performance (Fewer Crashes)

- Updates often fix the "bugs" that make your computer freeze or run slowly. An updated computer is a smoother computer.
- **Chip's Tip: If an app keeps "crashing," check the App Store or Windows Update—a fix is likely already waiting for you.**

3. Set It and Forget It

- You don't have to remember to update manually. Most devices have an "Automatic Updates" setting.
- **Chip's Tip: Enable "Automatic Updates" so your computer does the heavy lifting while you sleep!**
