Topic: What is "The Cloud" Anyway?

### 1. The "Safety Deposit Box" Analogy

- The Cloud isn't in the sky; it's just a secure computer owned by a company like Google or Apple that holds your files for safekeeping.
- **Chip's Tip: Storing things in the Cloud means that even if you drop your phone in a lake, your photos are still safe!**

### 2. Access from Anywhere

- Because your files are "online," you can start a letter on your laptop and finish it on your tablet later.
- **Chip's Tip: This is the easiest way to share a large batch of family photos without having to email them one by one.**

### 3. Saving Space at Home

- Cloud storage lets you keep thousands of files without filling up your phone's limited memory.
- **Chip's Tip: Use the "Free Up Space" setting on your phone to remove photos that are already safely backed up to the Cloud.**
