Topic: "Streaming" vs. "Cable"

1. What is Streaming?

- Streaming just means watching TV through your internet connection instead of a cable wire. It's usually much cheaper but requires a good Wi-Fi connection.
- **Chip's Tip: Think of streaming like a "Digital Buffet"—you only pay for the channels you actually want to eat.**

2. The Remote Control Shuffle

- Switching to streaming often means using a different remote (like a Roku or Fire TV Stick) or a different "Input" on your TV.
- **Chip's Tip: Label your remotes with a small piece of tape so you remember which one controls the volume and which one controls the show!**

3. Don't Pay Twice

- Many people pay for cable AND streaming services they don't use. Check your monthly bills for apps like Netflix or Hulu that you might have forgotten.
- **Chip's Tip: If you haven't watched a specific app in 3 months, cancel it! You can always sign up again later.**
