Topic: Is an E-Reader Right for You?

1. Easy on the Eyes

- Unlike a phone, e-readers use "e-ink," which looks just like paper. It doesn't have a glare, even in direct sunlight.
- **Chip's Tip: You can make the font as big as you want! It's like having a Large Print edition of every book ever made.**

2. A Library in Your Pocket

- You can hold thousands of books on one device that weighs less than a single paperback.
- **Chip's Tip: Most local libraries let you "borrow" e-books for free using an app called Libby. No more late fees!**

3. Battery for Weeks

- Because e-readers use so little power, you only have to charge them once every few weeks, not every single night.
- **Chip's Tip: If you love reading in bed, look for a model with a "Warm Light" setting—it's much gentler on your eyes.**
