Topic: Cleaning Up Your Digital Photos

1. Delete the "Duds."

- We often take 5 photos of the same thing to get one good one. Delete the 4 blurry ones immediately!
- **Chip's Tip: Be ruthless! If you wouldn't print it and frame it, you probably don't need to keep it forever.**

2. Use "Favorites" (The Heart Icon)

- Tap the heart icon on your best photos. This puts them into a special "Favorites" album so you can find them in seconds.
- **Chip's Tip: This is the easiest way to show off your grandkids' latest photos without scrolling through 1,000 pictures of your lunch.**

3. Screenshots are Clutter

- We often take "Screenshots" of recipes or reminders and then forget about them. They eat up a lot of space over time.
- **Chip's Tip: Once a month, search your photo app for "Screenshots" and delete the ones you've already dealt with.**
