Topic: How to Share Photos Safely

1. Don't Email 50 Photos

- Sending too many photos in one email can make it "too big" to send or receive.
- **Chip's Tip: Use a "Shared Link" from Google Photos or iCloud instead. It's much faster and easier for everyone.**

2. Privacy Check

- When you share a link to an album, make sure "Collaborate" is turned off unless you want others to be able to delete your photos!
- **Chip's Tip: You can always "Stop Sharing" a link later if you change your mind.**

3. Watch Out for "Social Media" Blur

- Facebook often "shrinks" your photos to make them load faster, which makes them look blurry if someone tries to print them.
- **Chip's Tip: If you want someone to print a photo, send the "Original" file through a text message or a shared link**
