Topic: Summer Tech Safety

1. Phones Hate the Sun

- If your phone gets too hot, the screen will dim, and it might even shut down to protect itself.
- **Chip's Tip: Never leave your phone in a parked car or on a sunny poolside table. Keep it in the shade!**

2. Sand is the Enemy

- A single grain of sand can scratch your screen or get stuck in your charging port.
- **Chip's Tip: If you're going to the beach, keep your phone in a sealed Ziploc bag—you can still use it through the plastic!**

3. Watch Out for "Public" Chargers

- Those USB charging stations at airports can sometimes be used by hackers to steal data.
- **Chip's Tip: Always use your own "Wall Plug" instead of just plugging your cord directly into a public USB port.**
