Topic: Android Tablet Basics (Samsung & Google)

1. The Three-Button Navigation

- Most Android tablets have three icons at the bottom: a **Triangle** (Back), a **Circle** (Home), and a **Square** (Open Apps).
- **Chip's Tip: If you get stuck, just tap the Circle. It's your "Safety Net" that always takes you back to the start.**

2. The Notification "Pull-Down."

- Swipe your finger down from the very top of the screen to see your alerts, adjust your brightness, or turn on your Wi-Fi.
- **Chip's Tip: You can swipe down with two fingers to see even more settings, like the Flashlight or Airplane Mode.**

3. Multitasking for the Big Screen

- Tablets are great for seeing two things at once. You can drag one app to the side of the screen to look at a recipe while you check your email.
- **Chip's Tip: This is called "Split Screen," and it's much easier to use on a tablet than on a small phone!**
