Topic: Photo "Purge" Party

1. The Screenshot Sweep

- Search your photos for "screenshots" and delete the ones you no longer need, such as old grocery lists or flight info.
- **Chip's Tip: Deleting just 50 "blurry" photos a week keeps your device fast and saves you money on storage fees.**

2. Sync Before You Delete

- Ensure your cloud backup (iCloud or Google Photos) is "up to date" before you start your cleanup.
- **Chip's Tip: This "Safety Net" ensures that if you accidentally delete a "keeper," you can still recover it from the cloud.**

3. Clear the Bursts

- If you accidentally took 10 photos of the same thing, pick the best one and delete the other 9 immediately.
- **Chip's Tip: Your phone's search bar can help you find "Duplicates" automatically to make this job even easier.**
